

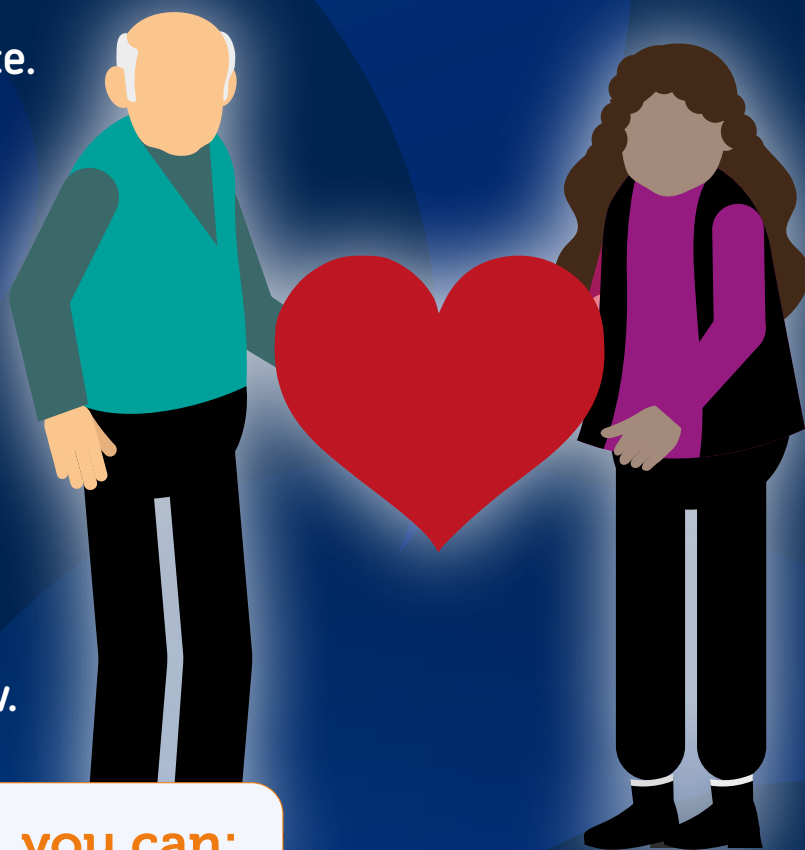
# Do you live in a care home? Or know someone who does?

Care homes should support this and not normally put barriers or restrictions in place.

Everyone has the right to respect for their private and family life, which is reflected in the Health and Social Care Standards, which all care services should follow.
