About the service

Carriagehill Nursery, Green Road is registered to provide a care service to a maximum of 50 children not yet attending primary school, at any one time of whom; no more than 10 are aged under two years; no more than 12 are aged two years to under three years and; no more than 28 are aged three years to those not yet attending primary school full time. At the time of inspection there were 35 children in attendance. The registered provider is Carriagehill Nursery Ltd.

The service has sole use of a building based in Paisley, Renfrewshire. Children have access to a large playroom for children over three years, with an area sectioned off for children aged two to under three years. Both areas have direct access to an outdoor play area. There is a separate room for children aged 0-2 years with access to a small, covered deck area. The service is close to shops, schools, transport routes and other amenities.

About the inspection

This was an unannounced follow up inspection which took place on 7 August 2025. The inspection was carried out by two inspectors from the Care Inspectorate. The inspection focused on the requirement made during the previous inspection which took place on 22 and 23 April 2025. We evaluated how the service had addressed this requirement to ensure that the service adheres to the conditions of registration. During this follow-up inspection, we identified that this requirement is now met, because the service had made progress by completing an action plan, which supported quality assurance measures to continually review numbers of children attending the service.

Key messages

Improvement was evident with the requirement made during the previous inspection. As a result, children's care and support is provided in a planned and safe way.

What the service has done to meet any requirements we made at or since the last inspection

Requirements

Requirement 1

By 23rd of July 2025, the provider must ensure that the service adheres to the Conditions of registration. To do this, the provider must, at a minimum:

- a) Ensure the maximum number of children attending within each age range, does not exceed the number stated on the registration certificate.
- b) Provide evidence that action has been taken to ensure the service is working within the conditions of registration.

This is to comply with SSI 2011/210 Regulation 4(1)(a) and (d) (Welfare of users) of The Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland (Requirements for Care Services) Regulations 2011 (SSI 2011/210) to ensure conditions of registration are adhered to at all times) My care and support is provided in a planned and safe way, including if there is an emergency or unexpected event. (HSCS 4.14)

This requirement was made on 7 August 2025.

Action taken on previous requirement

We were satisfied with the progress the service had made for this requirement. An action plan with clear timescales had allowed the management team to review systems in place and make necessary changes.

a) We sampled registers within the last 3 months and were able to identify that the number of children attending each day did not exceed the number stated on the registration certificate. Additionally, we completed an aide memoire which also confirmed that the service met their registration conditions.

b) The manager and depute had undertaken training to effectively record children's attendance. Through discussions, we identified that both the manager and depute have a clearer understanding of children's attendance patterns and ensuring they are adhering to the conditions of registration. Ongoing training is also being carried out as and when required.

The manager had worked alongside the staff team to ensure all staff are aware of their responsibilities to record children's attendance, as well as management having an overview through quality assurance planning. This is now part of daily quality assurance measures.
